RNOSC members decided to hold the elections before Tokyo 2020 Olympic Games.

Today, 17th April 2021, the Rwanda National Olympic and Sports Committee (RNOSC) held its Extraordinary General Assembly following the resignation of Amb. Valens Munyabagisha from his position as the RNOSC President on April 05th, 2021.

During this extraordinary meeting, chaired by the IOC Member and Acting President Mrs. RWEMARIKA Félicité, the RNOSC members (National Sports Federations/Associations) noted the resignation of Amb. Valens Munyabagisha as the NOC President.

As a result, the General Assembly unanimously took a resolution to reverse its previous decision on the date of elections and resolved to hold the new Executive committee elections on May 8th, 2021.

In her closing remarks, the IOC Member and RNOSC Acting President Mrs. RWEMARIKA Félicité reminded the members that this is the important time to live the Olympic values by staying united and make sure that Team Rwanda preparations' ahead of Tokyo 2020 Olympic Games will not be disrupted.
